Job Description

Role and Responsibilities

- Disassemble Allison automatic transmission cores.
- Inspect AT components to determine what parts that are able to be re-used.
- Polish, clean and prepare parts for resale.
- Work with management and sales team to organize work flow to ensure the customer is priority one.
- Maintain a tidy well organized work area.
- Ensure that disassembly process promotes safety and is in accordance with OSHA and other appropriate standards.
- Utilize and maintain required personal protective equipment as required for position and individual tasks. Examples include: safety shoes, safety glasses, gloves, etc.
- Operate a forklift and other company vehicles observing applicable laws and licensing requirements.
- May be needed to deliver or pick up parts from in-state customers

Qualifications and equipment needed

- 1-3 years prior experience with heavy duty Allison automatic transmissions
